The "Talent in Mobility" awards, the event honouring for the first time Europe's sustainable mobility professionals

To coincide with Transports Publics 2010, the European mobility exhibition to be held on June 8-10 in Paris, **GIE Objectif transport public** is creating the "Talent in Mobility" awards. This new prize is designed to honour women and men who are contributing to the development of public transport and sustainable mobility across Europe.

The event will highlight individuals who are making European mobility what it is today - and who will be shaping the way it looks in the future. **"The 'Talent in Mobility' awards aim to raise awareness of the important contributions of outstanding players in a sector which usually has a tendency to emphasise plant rather than people"**, says Joël Lebreton, Chairman of GIE Objectif transport public.

Any individual working in mobility in Europe may be nominated, whether they belong to an industrial company, an operator, a transport organising authority, a service company, a non-profit body, a government ministry or department, and so on.

The jury panel, made up of European journalists specialising in the sector, will be selecting four "Talents", honouring four professionals nominated by their peers: the best young "Talent", the best project manager, the best manager and a "special career service" award.

A fifth prize will be awarded by Internet users by voting on the website, www.transportspublics-expo.com, between March 29 and April 23, 2010.

Nominations are invited from any professional working in the field. All they need to do is **complete the nomination form, which can be downloaded from www.transportspublics-expo.com website, and return it by the February 26 deadline.**

The awards ceremony will be held on June 10, in Paris, at the Transports Publics 2010 exhibition.
